

## **PREP CLUBS**

Prep students will have the opportunity to sign-up for clubs in September. Clubs will begin meeting in late September or early October. We ask that parents review the club descriptions with their daughters and help them make wise selections. Every effort will be made to give each student one of her four choices.

The following clubs will be offered this school year. Clubs will meet twice a month, on the second and fourth Wednesdays of the month.

**CAMPUS MINISTRY** – This club will help take care of the shrine and chapel. They will prepare monthly birthday nametags and deliver them to the classroom teachers/moderators. The students may serve as greeters for the Elementary School liturgies and assist visitors with seating. This group will also be responsible for planning a liturgy.

**CHORUS (PREP)** – The chorus is designed for those who love to sing and want more in-depth instruction on healthy vocal technique. Members will sing for all elementary school masses as cantors. Music will be mainly liturgical, and more if the schedule permits.

**CREATIVE WRITING** – This club will explore many types of creative writing – short stories, poems, plays, etc. We will spend time brainstorming about writing projects, working on them, and sharing efforts.

**CROCHET CLUB** – Students in this club will learn the basics of crocheting. They will be able to create projects and experience the joy and pleasure of relaxing with a lifetime art. Students will be required to purchase some supplies.

**FITNESS CLUB** - This club focuses on issues of being fit, including nutrition, fitness tests and exercise. Several fitness games will be incorporated, along with discussions on fitness topics.

**FRENCH CLUB** - This club is aimed at promoting the use of the French Language and an appreciation of the Francophone Culture, as well as providing social interaction. Students will participate in a variety of activities, mostly twofold: cultural (watching movies, baking / cooking, French magazines distribution), and educational (weekly French conversations, guest speakers).

**GARDEN CLUB** – In this club, students will help select seeds/plants and grow and maintain a flower garden.

**LIBRARY CLUB** – Students involved with the library club will learn about the arrangement of the library (Dewey Decimal System, etc.) by shelving returned books, checking the shelves for order, performing helpful tasks, learning bits of library lore, and engaging in bookish pastimes.

**KIDS CARE SERVICE CLUB** -This GOAL III club will be helping with recycling paper and cardboard, collecting gently used Halloween Costumes for Thensted Center, preparing and delivering Christmas Boxes for the Thensted Center, and working with the High School Service Club to conduct Saturday Fun Days!

**SERVICE CLUB** – This club will be in charge of organizing and helping with the implementation of major Goal III projects for the year. These projects include: recycling paper and cardboard, food collection and delivery to the Thensted Center pantry, Christmas Caring, Toiletries for Shelters, assisting “Doctor’s without Borders”, Box Tops for Education, decorating seasonal gift bags for the Missionaries of Charity, and helping with the sponsorship of Saturday Fun Days at the Thensted Center.
